1. Background

MEUSAC (the Malta-EU Steering and Action Committee) is an agency established by Legal Notice 154 of 2017 and in terms of the Public Administration Act (Cap. 595) to carry out functions related to consultation on European Union (EU) policy and legislation, EU-related information and assistance on EU funding programmes.

2. Services required

MEUSAC (hereafter referred to as the 'Contracting Authority') is seeking a reputable service provider for the provision of services of high-quality filming, editing and production of three (3), 60-second each, promotional video clips.

The full specifications are found in Section 4 below.

3. Timeframes

The timeframes for the completion of this Call for Quotations are:

4. Deliverables

The Contracting Authority will commission a reputable firm or individual to provide the following:

A) Filming Services

The general filming at six (6) different locations, identified by the Contracting Authority, for the production of three (3) video clips, each of sixty (60) seconds. Filming will consist of general background filming related to EU-funded projects in Malta.

- i. Filming on location using one camera operated by a manual camera operator.
- ii. Filming is to take place in six (6) locations (both indoors and outdoors) in Malta that are pre-determined by the Contracting Authority.
- iii. For one of the video clips, the service provider will be required to provide drone/aerial shots.
- iv. For the filming of every video, the selected service provider is to provide all necessary equipment together with manual camera operator for filming at the pre-determined location.
- v. Service provider is to have all necessary permits to perform the drone/aerial filming.

General provisions:

- i. The picture must be well lit and not artificially sharp.
- ii. Camera type is to be of high broadcast quality.
- iii. The final product shall be in full HD resolution.
- iv. Format scale of production is to be 16x9.
- v. The picture must be free of excessive noise, grain and digital compression artefacts.
- vi. The picture must be free of excessive flare, reflections, lens dirt, markings and obstructions (e.g. lens hood), and lens aberrations.
- vii. Movement must appear smooth and continuous and must not give rise to distortions or break-up to moving objects or cause large changes in resolution.
- viii. The picture must be free of excessive black crushing and highlight compression.

- ix. The picture must be stable and continuous - i.e. no jumps, movements, shifts in level or position.
- x. The audio must be free of spurious signals such as clicks, noise, hum and any analogue distortion. The audio must be reasonably continuous and smoothly mixed and edited.
- xi. Drone/aerial shots are to be of high quality and same resolution as the rest of the video.

B) Editing and Production Services

Production of edited features, including video editing.

Three (3) edited video clip productions of up to a maximum of sixty (60) seconds for each production. The three (3) video clips are planned to be produced in the following months: August, September and October 2020.

- i. The service provider is to provide enhanced editing of the filming, music bed, narration and sub-titles and to make the video clips as interesting as possible.
- ii. Editing is to include an intro and outro animated slide, provided by the Contracting Authority.
- iii. The music bed is to be played throughout the videos with high points during the intro and outro and low points during narration.
- iv. The service provider is to provide the services of a narrator. The script for the video narration will be prepared by Contracting Authority in Maltese. English sub-titles are to be included in the video clips during editing. Proof reading of the sub-titles will be the Contracting Authority's sole responsibility.
- v. The narration is to be done by a radio personality who is featured on one of Malta's leading radio stations.
- vi. The winning bidder will be expected to provide the Contracting Authority with an option of one (1) male and one (1) female radio personality, within five (5) working days from the award of the contract. The Contracting Authority will choose the preferred voice for the three (3) video clips or request other names if it considers the proposed names to be unsuitable. In this case, names are also to be provided within five (5) working days from notification. This is to be done without prejudice to one's right to gender-identity recognition and self-determination.

General provisions:

- i. The MP4 format should be provided in HD High-Quality format.
- ii. Format of exportation should be presented in both MXF OP1a for TV and/or MP4 for social media.
- iii. Each production is to be delivered as a single principal MXF file containing the audio and video, and for social media as a single file MP4 containing the audio and video.
- iv. All clips are to end with a fade or cut to silence before the intended end point. Any fade-out or reverb must be allowed for within the clip duration.
- v. No font can be re-scaled or stretched (deformed).
- vi. Captions and credits must be clear and legible and must be within the specified safe areas. All font sizes must be legible as HD.
- vii. All material delivered for Maltese HD TV transmission must be 1920 x 1080 pixels in an aspect ratio of 16:9 and 25 frames per second (50 fields) interlaced (1080i/50i).
- viii. All drone/aerial shots are to be of the same resolution as the rest of the video.
- ix. All the above requirements are to be automatically required unless otherwise confirmed by the Contracting Authority. Each final video filming and production will be considered as final following the approval of the Contracting Authority.
- x. Final video clips are to be delivered to the Contracting Authority by a set date agreed to by the winning bidder and the Contracting Authority.
- xi. All Logos, Fonts, Intros and Outros, lower thirds, sub-titles and captions will be provided by the Contracting Authority.

5. Selection and Award Requirements

In order to be considered eligible for the award of the contract, bidders must provide evidence that they meet or exceed certain minimum criteria described hereunder, by submitting the following Annexes as per Call for Quotations Dossier:

(A) Eligibility Criteria

- i) Details of Bidder (Annex 1)
- ii) Bidder's Declaration (Annex 2)

(B) Financial Offer

- i) A filled-in Financial Bid Form (Annex 4), including a clear breakdown of all items.

6. Award Criteria

The contract will be awarded to the cheapest, technically compliant quotation.

7. Cancellation of the Call for Quotations Procedure

In the event of the cancellation of a Call for Quotations procedure, bidders will be notified by the Contracting Authority.

Cancellation may occur where:

- The Call for Quotations procedure has been unsuccessful, namely where no quotations or no suitable quotations have been submitted;
- The economic or technical parameters of the project have been fundamentally altered;
- The exceptional circumstances or *force majeure* render normal performance of the project impossible;
- There have been irregularities in the procedure, in particular where these have prevented fair competition;
- All technically compliant quotations exceed the financial resources available.

In no circumstances will the Contracting Authority be liable for damages, whatever their nature (in particular damages for loss of profits) or relationship to the cancellation of a quotation, even if the Contracting Authority has been advised of the possibility of damages. The publication of a contract notice does not commit the Contracting Authority to implement the project announced.
